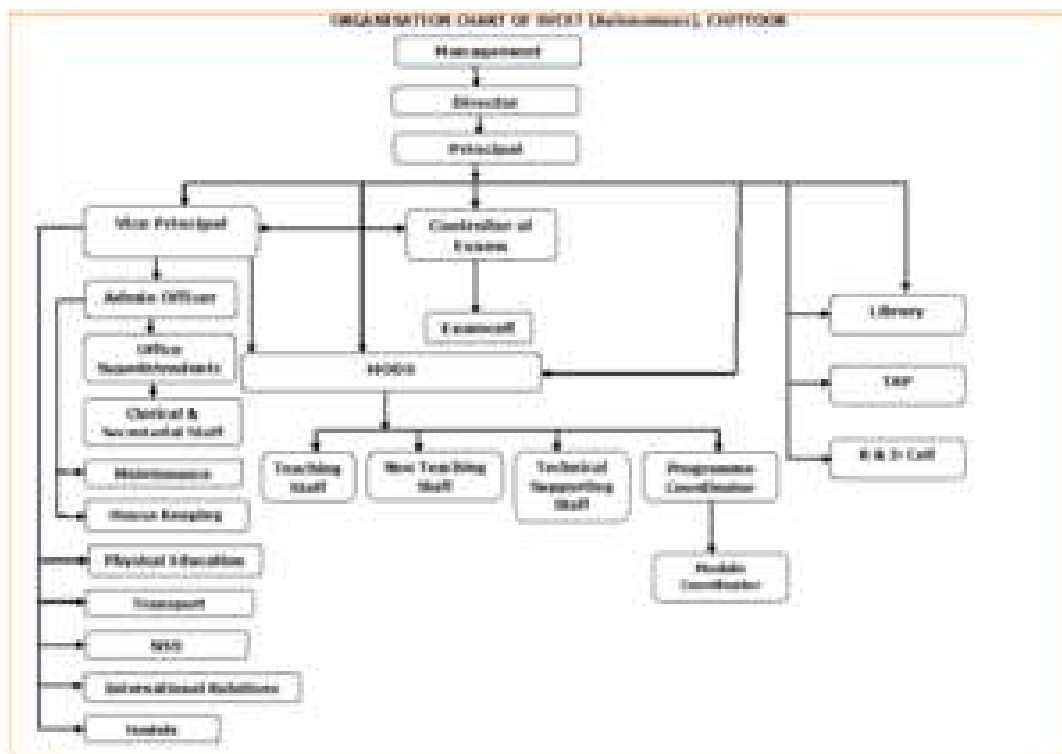

10.5.6 The management recognizes the need of an hour for decentralization for the growth of the institute and accords autonomy commensurate with the level of management. Various Heads are appointed who are given autonomy for efficient governance.

The roles and responsibilities of administrators / decision makers for various assigned jobs listed below clearly depict the delegation of authority, providing operational autonomy leading to a decentralized governance system.

Principal: To implement and monitor the education system to cater to the institute’s vision and mission.

Vice Principal (Academics): Is responsible for academic development of the institute academics, day to day academic activities and assuring quality in teaching and learning process and monitors progress of various teaching/learning processes.

R & D (Coordinator): Monitors Research and Development activities in the institute

Head of the department: Is responsible for the academic and administrative functions of the department. In addition, Administrative Officer, Accounts Officer, Librarian, take care of office related activities, finance related issues and library resources related activities. Other support functions are handled by the Admission-in-charge, NBA Coordinator, NAAC Coordinator, Industry Institute Interaction Cell Coordinator, NSS coordinator, NCC Coordinator.

At the department level:

- Each program has Diploma, UG and PG coordinators

- Planning, Preparation and organizing of activities is done by Time Table co-ordinator
- Each course has a course co-ordinator who, in consultation with the faculty teaching the subject, sets course objectives, prepares the teaching plan for the semester, conducts meetings with faculty regularly to monitor and review course completion and attainment of course outcomes and submits a report of the same to PAC through the module coordinator
- Class teachers/batch guardians are designated for all classes/batches

10.5.7 Student Feedback on Institutional Governance/faculty performance:

A student feedback mechanism is available in the institution. Student Feedback mechanism on Institutional governance and Faculty performance is obtained once in a semester. Feedback from the students will be reviewed and corrective measures are taken as per the feedback. With respect to faculty performance, feedback forms set as per ISO standards will be collected from the students and corrective measures if any will be suggested and implemented by the concerned faculty.

10.5.8 Grievance redressal mechanism for faculty, staff and students: Grievance redressal Cell was formulated to resolve the Grievances raised by the staff and students. In addition to that, suggestion box is provided at the principal's chamber to identify the grievances if any by the staff and students separately. Grievances of the faculty and staff will be discussed in person and the staff and students are made comfortable for their employment and course work respectively. In case of indiscipline, a committee appointed by the principal enquires into the matter by calling witnesses and recommendations are made about the action to be taken by the management.

Functions

1. To display Posters, Rules, Punishment and fines regarding ragging sent by JNTU/ AICTE in all notice boards, canteen, college buses, vehicle stand etc.

10. To counsel the senior students by the faculty members for not indulging in any ragging activities.
11. To organize " Awareness Programme on Anti -Ragging" by the Police officials.
12. To organize the Legal Literacy Camp to create awareness amongst the students, faculty members and parents about the ragging acts and punishments by the legal authorities.

The assessment process is outlined for theory and laboratory courses, which is common for all the years. Project seminar currently applies to IV year students.

Theory Courses: For B.Tech

- Two internal examinations are conducted in every semester, one each after 8 weeks of instruction.
- The subject coverage for each internal is 2 Units of the syllabus.
- Each theory course will be evaluated for a total of 100 Marks, with 40 Marks for Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) and 60 Marks for Semester End Examination (SEE).

Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA)

- The distribution of marks for Continuous Internal Assessment is as follows:

Two Sessional Examinations: 25 Marks

Two Quiz Examinations : 10 Marks

2 Assignments : 05 Marks

- The question paper is common for all the students of a class. The time of examination for each subject is also common for all the students thereby ensuring utmost transparency.
- The questions are followed by the Course Outcome (CO) number, to facilitate the student and the teacher about the attainment of the CO by the student as well as the class.
- The corrected answer scripts are given back to students and grievance of any student regarding valuation is addressed by the teacher.

Laboratory courses:

- Students are assessed on continuous basis by awarding marks for their performance of individual experiments which is communicated during the next class.
- Each Laboratory Course will be evaluated for a total of 100 marks, consisting of 40 marks for internal assessment (CIA) and 60 marks for semester end lab examination. Out of 40marks of CIA, continuous lab assessment (SEE) for day to day performance will be done for 20 marks, final internal lab examination carries 15 marks and Viva-Voce carries 5 marks.
- The semester end lab examination for 60 marks shall be conducted by two examiners, one of them being internal examiner (subject teacher) and the other being external examiner (other than the teacher handled) to be nominated by the Principal from the panel of experts as recommended by the Chairman, BOS. The scheme of valuation for the 60 Marks will be informed to the students in advance by the concerned Chairman, BOS and displayed in the laboratory during the beginning of the semester.

Final year Project:

- There shall be a Project Work in the IV year second semester which carries 12 credits. Out of 100 marks allotted for the project work, 40 marks shall be for Internal Evaluation and 60 marks for the End Semester Examination (Viva – Voce). The Viva – Voce shall be conducted by a committee consisting of HOD, Project Supervisor and an External Examiner nominated by the Principal from the panel of examiners recommended by Chairman, BOS. The Evaluation of project work shall be conducted at the end of the IV year – II semester. The Internal Evaluation shall be made by the departmental committee, on the basis of two seminars given by each student on the topic of his project.
- Presentation is divided between the members of the project group, but each student is expected to know

the complete system.

- The methods adapted are different depending on the nature of the subject. However, the assessment process for each type is well defined. Thus the internal assessment processes are transparent and robust in terms of frequency and variety

INTERNAL ASSESSMENT: DIPLOMA

Theory Subjects: Theory Subjects carry 20% sessional marks, Internal examinations will be conducted for awarding sessional marks on the dates specified. Three unit tests will be conducted for I year students and two Unit Tests for semesters. Average of marks obtained in all the prescribed tests will be considered for awarding the sessional marks.

Practical Subjects:

- Student's performance in Laboratories / Workshop shall be assessed during the year/ semester of study for 40% marks in each practical subject. Allotment of marks should be discrete taking into consideration of the students' skills, accuracy, recording and performance of the task assigned to him / her. Each student has to write a record / log book for assessment purpose. In the subject of Drawing, which is also considered as a practical paper, the same rules hold good. Drawing exercises are to be filed in seriatum.
- Internal assessment in Labs / workshops / Survey field work etc., during the course of study shall be done and sessional marks shall be awarded by the concerned Lecturer / Senior Lecturer / Workshop superintendent as the case may be.
- For practical examinations, except in drawing, there shall be two examiners. External examiner shall be appointed by the Principal in consultation with respective Head of Section preferably choosing a qualified person from any local Industry/ nearby Government Polytechnic/ Local Government Organization. The end examination shall be held along with all theory papers in respect of drawing.
- Records pertaining to internal assessment marks of both theory and practical subjects are to be maintained for official inspection.
- In case of Diploma courses having Industrial Training, the training assessment shall be done and the marks are to be awarded in the following manner.
- Industrial assessment: 200 marks (in two spells of 100 marks each)
- Maintenance of log book: 30 marks

Record Work: 30 marks

Seminar / viva-voce: 40 marks

TOTAL: 300 marks

- The assessment at the institution level (Seminar/Viva-voce) shall be done by three members, viz., Internal Faculty member, External Examiner and Head of Section and be averaged.

Internal Assessment: M.Tech

- The performance of the candidate in each semester shall be evaluated subject wise, with a maximum of 100 marks for Theory and 100 marks for practical's, on the basis of Internal Evaluation and End Semester Examination.

- For the theory subjects 60% of the marks will be for the External End Examination. While 40% of the marks will be for Internal Evaluation, based on the average of the marks secured in the two Mid Term-Examinations held, one in the middle of the Semester (first two units) and another immediately after the completion of instruction (last three units) with four questions to be answered out of five in 2 hours, evaluated for 40 marks.
- For practical subjects, 60 marks shall be for the End Semester Examinations and 40 marks will be for internal evaluation based on the day to day performance (25 marks) and practical test at the end of the semester (15 marks).
- Seminar is a continuous assessment process. For Seminar there will be an internal evaluation of 50 marks. A candidate has to secure a minimum of 50% to be declared successful. The assessment will be made by a board consisting of HOD and two internal experts.
- For comprehensive viva voce there will be an internal evaluation of 100 marks. A candidate has to secure a minimum of 50% to be declared successful. The assessment will be made by a board consisting of HOD and two internal experts.

Internal Continuous Evaluation System- (R-20)

For B.Tech Course

Theory Course: Each theory course will be evaluated for a total of 100 Marks, with 30 Marks for Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) and 70 Marks for Semester End Examination (SEE).

Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA):

The distribution of marks for Continuous Internal Assessment is as follows:

- Two Sessional Examinations: 25 Marks
- Five Assignments: 05 Marks
- Each sessional exam question paper consists of two parts, namely Part A and Part B. Part A is compulsory which carries 5 marks and consists of five short answer type questions with each carrying 1 mark. In Part B, 4 essay type questions with internal choice (either or type) each carrying 5 marks may be given.
- The questions may be set as per Bloom's Taxonomy. Time duration for each sessional exam is 2 hours. Internal marks for sessional examinations shall be arrived at by considering the marks secured by the student in both the sessional examinations with 80% weightage to the better sessional exam and 20% to the other.
- Five assignments, each one for 05 marks shall be given to the students at the end of each unit. Internal marks for the assignments shall be awarded by considering the average of the five assignments.

Laboratory Course:

- Each Laboratory Course will be evaluated for a total of 100 marks, consisting of 40 marks for internal assessment (CIA) and 60 marks for semester end lab examination. Out of 40marks of CIA, continuous lab assessment (SEE) for day to day performance will be done for 20 marks, final internal lab examination carries 15 marks and Viva-Voce carries 5 marks.
- The semester end lab examination for 60 marks shall be conducted by two examiners, one of them being internal examiner (subject teacher) and the other being external examiner (other than the teacher handled)

to be nominated by the Principal from the panel of experts as recommended by the Chairman, BOS. The scheme of valuation for the 60 Marks will be informed to the students in advance by the concerned Chairman, BOS and displayed in the laboratory during the beginning of the semester.

Mandatory Courses:

- Mandatory courses will not carry any credits; but, a pass in the examination during the programme shall be necessary requirement for student to qualify for the award of Degree.
- The student is declared pass in each such course after securing 40% of the marks in internal examination. Evaluation will be done by conducting descriptive examination at the end of the semester for 100 marks, internally. Its result shall be declared with “satisfactory” (Pass) or Not Satisfactory (Fail) performance. Attendance is mandatory for these courses.
- The examination will be conducted for 100 marks of 3 hours duration. The syllabus for the course is divided into FIVE units. The Question Paper consists of two parts, Part A and Part B. Part A consists of 5 short answer type questions, each carries 5 marks for a total of 25 marks with no choice. Part B Consists of 5 questions with one question from each of the 5 units with internal choice with 15 marks for each question.
- The emphasis on the questions is broadly based on objective skill, analytical skill and application skill following the outcome based education.

Project Work:

- There shall be a Project Work in the IV year second semester which carries 12 credits. Out of 100 marks allotted for the project work, 40 marks shall be for Internal Evaluation and 60 marks for the End Semester Examination (Viva – Voce). The Viva – Voce shall be conducted by a committee consisting of HOD, Project Supervisor and an External Examiner nominated by the Principal from the panel of examiners recommended by Chairman, BOS. The Evaluation of project work shall be conducted at the end of the IV year – II semester. The Internal Evaluation shall be made by the departmental committee, on the basis of two seminars given by each student on the topic of his project.

Framework for Mandatory Internships:

- Two summer internships each with a minimum of six weeks duration, done at the end of second and third years, respectively are mandatory. The internship can be done by the students at local industries, Govt. Organizations, construction agencies, Industries, Hydel and thermal power projects and also in software MNCs.
- Evaluation of the summer internships shall be through the departmental committee. A student will be required to submit a summer internship report to the concerned department and appear for an oral presentation before the departmental committee. The report and the oral presentation shall carry 40% and 60% weightages respectively.
- In the final semester, the student should mandatorily undergo internship and parallelly he should work on a project with well-defined objectives. At the end of the semester the candidate shall submit an internship completion certificate and a project report. A student shall also be permitted to submit project report on the work carried out during the internship. The project report shall be evaluated with an external examiner.
- The College shall facilitate and monitor the student internship programs. Completion of internships is

mandatory, if any student fails to complete internship, he will not be eligible for the award of degree. In such cases, the student shall repeat and complete the internship.

For MBA Course

- For the theory subjects, 60 marks will be for the Semester End Examination. The other 40 marks will be for Internal Evaluation, out of which 20 marks for Mid Term-Examinations, which shall be arrived at by considering marks secured by the student in both the mid-term examinations with 80% weightage for the better mid-term exam and 20% to other the exam. Out of the remaining 20 marks for internal valuation, 10 marks will be for case analysis (one case analysis of 10 Marks at the end of each unit, 5 such case analysis, weighted for 10 Marks), and 10 marks for the assignment in the concerned subject (one assignment of 10 Marks at the end of each unit, 5 such assignments, weighted for 10 Marks).
- The first Mid exam will be conducted in the middle of the Semester (First two units) and another immediately after the completion of instruction (Last three units) with four questions (with internal choice, either or type) to be answered in 2 hours, evaluated for 20 marks
- For semester-end examination, five questions shall be given for a maximum of 50 marks with one question from each unit with internal choice, either or type, carrying 10 marks each, and 10 marks for the case study.
- Each Laboratory Course (Business Communication: Theory and Practice, and Introduction to Business Analytics) will be evaluated for a total of 100 marks, consisting of 40 marks for internal assessment and 60 marks for semester end lab examination. Out of 40 marks of internal assessment, continuous lab assessment for day to day performance will be done for 20 marks, final internal lab examination carries 15 marks and Viva-Voce carries 5 marks. The semester end lab examination for 60 marks shall be conducted by two examiners, one of them being internal examiner (subject teacher) and the other being external examiner (other than the teacher handled) to be nominated by the Principal from the panel of experts as recommended by the Chairman, BOS. The scheme of valuation for the 60 Marks will be informed to the students in advance by the concerned Chairman, BOS and displayed in the laboratory during the beginning of the semester.
- For the Seminar, there will be an internal evaluation of 100 marks. A candidate has to secure a minimum of 50% to be declared successful. The assessment will be made by a board consisting of HOD and two internal experts.
- For the project, out of 200 marks, 80 marks shall be for Internal Evaluation and 120 marks for the End Semester Examination. The End Semester Examination (viva-voce) shall be conducted by the committee consisting of an External examiner nominated by the Chief Controller Of Examinations, HOD & Supervisor. The evaluation of project work shall be conducted at the end of the IV semester. The Internal Evaluation shall be made by the departmental committee, on the basis of two seminars, each for 40 marks, given by each student on the topic of his project.
- A candidate shall be deemed to have secured the minimum academic requirement in a subject if he secures a minimum of 40% of marks in the End Examination and a minimum aggregate of 50% of the total marks in the End Semester Examination and Internal Evaluation, taken together.

Project Work:

Every candidate shall be required to submit a thesis or dissertation after taking up a topic approved by the

college/ institute.

- Registration of Project work: A candidate is permitted to register for the project work after satisfying the attendance requirement of I, II, and III Semesters.
- An Internal Departmental Committee (I.D.C) consisting of HOD, Supervisor, and one internal senior teacher shall monitor the progress of the project work.
- The candidate can submit the Project thesis with the approval of I.D.C. at the end of the IV semester instruction as per the schedule. Extension of time within the total permissible limit for completing the programme is to be obtained from the Head of the Institution.
- The student must submit a status report at least in two different phases during the project work period. These reports must be approved by the I.D.C before submission of the Project Report and award internal assessment marks for 80.
- The viva-voce examination may be conducted for all the candidates as per the IV semester examination schedule.
- Three copies of the Thesis / Dissertation certified in the prescribed form by the supervisor and HOD shall be presented to the HOD. One copy is to be forwarded to the Controller Of Examination and one copy is retained in the department.
- The Department shall submit a panel of three experts for a maximum of 20 students at a time. However, the Thesis / Dissertation will be adjudicated by one examiner nominated by the Chief Controller Of Examination.
- If the report of the examiner is favorable viva-voce examination shall be conducted by a board consisting of the Supervisor, Head of the Department, and the examiner who adjudicated the thesis/dissertation. The board shall jointly award the marks for 120.
- A candidate shall be deemed to have secured the minimum academic requirement in the project work if he secures a minimum of 40% marks in the viva-voce examination and a minimum aggregate of 50% of the total marks in the end viva-voce examination and the internal project report taken together. If he fails to get the minimum academic requirement he has to appear for the viva-voce examination again to get the minimum marks. If he fails to get the minimum marks at the second viva-voce examination he will not be eligible for the award of the degree, unless the candidate is asked to revise and resubmit. If the candidate fails to secure minimum marks again, the project shall be summarily rejected.
- Students are also encouraged to take up experiential projects through an internship in companies / industries, where senior executives with a stake in teaching and guiding them. In such cases, students will be associated with the identified industry for a minimum period of 6 weeks during the IV semester. During the Internship, the student should work on a project with well-defined objectives. At the end of the semester, the candidate shall submit an internship completion certificate and a project report. A student shall also be permitted to submit a project report on the work carried out during the internship. Evaluation in such cases will be the same as in the case of project work.

For MCA Course

- Internal Evaluation will be 40 marks, Out of which 30 marks will be based on the two Mid-term Examinations and 10 Marks will be based on assignments. Internal marks for mid-term examinations shall

be arrived at by considering the marks secured by the student in both the mid-term examinations with 80% weightage to the better midterm exam and 20% to the other.

- Five assignments, each one for 10 marks shall be given to the students at the end of each unit.
- Internal marks for the assignments shall be awarded by considering the average of the five assignments.

Mid-I: After first spell of instructions (I & II Units).

Mid-II: After second spell of instructions (III, IV & V Units).

- The question paper shall be of descriptive type with five essay type questions (internal choice with either or type) with each carrying 6 marks may be given.
- The questions may be set as per Bloom's Taxonomy. Time duration for each mid-term exam is 2 hours.

laboratory courses

- Laboratory courses evaluation will be done for a total of 40 marks which includes Day-to- Day evaluation for 25 Marks and Practical test for 15 marks at the end of semester.

Evaluation of Internship

- A student shall undergo Internship in an Industry/ National Laboratories relevant to the program of study. This course is to be registered in the second semester, and taken up during the summer vacation after completion of second semester for about FOUR weeks duration.
- The Internship shall be submitted in a Report form, and a presentation of the same shall be made before a Department Evaluation Committee (DEC). The DEC shall consist of Head of the Department, the concerned supervisor of Internship and a Senior Faculty Member of the Department.
- The DEC is constituted by the Principal on the recommendations of the Head of the Department. The Internship report shall be evaluated for 100 marks at the end of THIRD Semester.

Evaluation of Project Work

Every candidate shall be required to submit thesis or dissertation after taking up atopic approved by the college/ institute.

- A candidate is permitted to register for the project work after satisfying the attendance requirement of all the courses (theory and practical courses of I to III Semester)
- The Project Evaluation Committee (PEC) consisting of HOD, Supervisor and one internal senior faculty member shall monitor the progress of the project work.
- The work on the project shall be initiated in the penultimate semester and continued final semester.
- The candidate can submit Project thesis with the approval of PEC at the end of the IV semester instruction as per the schedule. Extension of time within the total permissible limit for completing the programme is to be obtained from the Head of the Institution.
- The student must submit status report at least in three different phases during the project work period.
- These reports must be approved by the PEC before submission of the Project Report and award internal assessment marks for 80.
- Three copies of the Thesis / Dissertation certified in the prescribed form by the supervisor and HOD shall

be presented to the HOD.

- The Department shall submit a panel of three experts for a maximum of 10 students to the principal for appointment of the external examiner.
- The Viva-voce examination shall be conducted by the board consisting of the Supervisor, Head of the Department and the external examiner nominated by the principal. The board shall jointly award the marks for 120.
- A candidate shall be deemed to have secured the minimum academic requirement of project work if he secures a minimum of 40% marks in the viva-voce examination and a minimum aggregate of 50% of the total marks in the end viva-voce examination and the internal assessment marks taken together. If he fails to get the minimum academic requirement he has to appear for the viva-voce examination again to get the minimum marks.
- The viva voce examination may be conducted once in two months for all the candidates who have submitted thesis during that period.
